








According to the prescriptions attached to the complementary decree dated August 9th 2018, Article 4 added as paragraph 4.16 « *Acceptation procedure of the containers intended to be cleaned* » to Article 4 « *Risks prevention* » of the prescriptions attached to the Prefectoral Decree dated December 18th 1995:

« *The containers intended to be cleaned which are received on site are empty and must be accompanied by a document which specifies:*

- *The origin of the containers (company name, address)*
- *The kind of containers*
- *The nature of the residues*
- *And the risks associated to these residues*

*These datas are registered and kept in a register available to the inspection of classified installations. »*

The washing station **is not allowed to wash** road tankers (...), **of the below classes** referred to in the modified regulation for the road transport of dangerous materials dated December 5<sup>th</sup> 2002 (named ADR decree) or any substituting regulation:

 <b>1</b> 	<b>Explosive substances and articles</b>
<b>2</b> 	<b>Gases</b>
<b>4</b> 	<b>Flammable liquids</b>
<b>5.2</b> 	<b>Oxidizing substances</b>
<b>6.2</b> 	<b>Infectious substances</b>
<b>7</b> 	<b>Radioactive material</b>

**Authorized classes are classes 3 – 5.1 – 6.1 – 8 and 9.**

Nevertheless, the manager of the cleaning station can be led to refuse a product which however belongs to these classes if he considers that the specificities of this current product do not fit with the used cleaning process and with the realized treatment of the effluents.
